Meeting called to order at 6:00pm

Brian O'Malley moved to approve meeting minutes from March 2013, Cherie Mittenthal second. All in favor.

Special guest Romolo Del Deo, sculptor of the Provincetown Fisherman's Memorial. emphasis of the location for a site-specific artwork. They've created plans and a model which are being used for fundraising. Project is organized by a private, volunteer group and has gotten approval from the Provincetown Art Commission and Board of Selectmen for the location in Fisherman's Park which is located between the two town piers.

Suggestion by Del Deo of a presentation which emphasizes the reasoning for the site.

He also suggested two locations: at the entrance to Provincetown or the Moors land between the Provincetown Inn and beginning of Bradford Street.

Del Deo was thanked for his time and left the meeting.

Discussion of the upcoming meeting with the Board of Selectmen scheduled for July 22, 2013. Brian O'Malley moved to ask the BOS to reinstate their original decision to allow the placement of the memorial at town hall. Francine D'Olimpio second. All in favor.

Idea to create an ad hoc group to help with the memorial. PCC will meet at 5:30pm July 22 to review talking points.

Endorsement letter reviewed. It is currently on Trudel's computer so she will contact the town regarding having it 'live' on the town's website so it can be easily accessed by members.

Added discussion of Cultural District Initiative to the September meeting agenda. September meeting is tentatively set for the second Monday of the month.

Discussion of term limits and elections which are currently overdue. Elections will occur at the September meeting.
