

CHARTER ENFORCEMENT COMMISSION

Dieter Groll, Complainant, entered the Meeting at 5:05

1. Dieter Groll filed a complaint, titled Memorandum of Objection, dated April 2, 2014, and a Supplemental Memorandum, dated April 4, 2014, under Section 5-2-3 of the Provincetown Charter alleging that David Gardner, the Acting Town Manager, and/or the Board of Selectmen failed to act in allowing the candidacy of Daniel Hoort, Finance Director for the Town of Provincetown, for an open seat on the Charter Enforcement Commission.
2. After reviewing the material presented by Mr. Groll, the Charter Enforcement Commission voted 4-0-0 to decline to dismiss the petition as presenting a potential issue for consideration.
3. Julia Perry will draft the Notice of Hearing setting the date and time for the hearing and send it to the Town Clerk. She will also prepare a letter to the Responding Official explaining the basis for the Commission decision to decline to dismiss the petition. The letter will be approved by the Commission before it is sent.
4. The Charter Enforcement Commission also voted 4-0-0 to approve the Minutes, as amended (correction of the spelling of a member's name) for the meetings of December 2, 2013, and March 5, 2014.
