

The **Provincetown Bicycling Committee** will have a Field Meeting on Wednesday, June 3, 2015 at 3:00 PM at Town Hall, 260 Commercial St., Provincetown, MA.

This meeting will be a working session with Barbara Jacobson from MassBike to get input for the feasibility of locating the Provincetown leg of the Rail Trail.

By bus/van we will ride from Town Hall to Route 6 to Stott Crossing in Truro and back up Route 6A to Mayflower Avenue.

From there we will walk the length of the Old Colony Nature Trail (formerly the Railroad bed) back to Howland St.

Those are the three potential routes for locating the Rail Trail Extension. This assessment and report from MassBike will form part of the background material before the decision is made.

Stakeholders [Conservation Commission, Disabilities Commission, DPW, etc.] are invited to join us.

Please notify us if someone from your committee will be present so we can assure sufficient materials.

No decisions are anticipated at this time. This is an information-gathering session.
