JC Discussed the island at Bradford and Standish. There is room for a 6-8 ft. boat to be planted with colorful annuals. It was decided not to accept the generous offer from Garden Renovations (to do the work and have signage in the garden) but BD moved to pay Garden Renovations \$2000 from the Budget. AC seconded. So voted 5-0. The Monday after Carnival, August 25, work is to start.

Solar Lights: EL marked the layout for the 17 lights in the Fishermen's Memorial Park and 4 into the Bus Stop Park.

RS moved to accept the minutes of July 30th. AC seconded. So voted 5-0.

BR wanted to hire a local arborist, Alligator Rauch, to trim the row of trees in the MLP. This was postponed to check on liability insurance. BR to order 2 pines as replacements at Fishermen's Memorial Park.

RS announces a \$1396.14 Balance in our Gift Fund. \$10,000 was received for our Budget August 9th from the VSB. \$13,721.38 actually \$13,221.38 in our Budget. We are planning on spending \$1500-\$2000 on the Old Library.
