Fundraising:

-Gay Men's Chorus concert and the Bayside Betsy's breakfast. No response has been received; Town Manager and Town Counsel will be consulted by the Chair.

-A memorial event for performer Pearlene is scheduled for June 26, with all proceeds to to the Memorial.

RFP: Ad budget of about \$6000 must be committed by the end of the month. Busa will compile a list of media outlets for advertisements, and will draft a press release to get editorial coverage. D'Olimpio will design the ad copy in collaboration with the Chair. Cicero suggests notice to regional arts schools, and will compile contacts.

MCC- Chair attended for 3 days for "Kaizen" event, felt it was very productive. Council members will receive direct communications from the MCC.

The grant process this year will be online, and awards will be given upon selection, without the requirement for compliance certification.

MCC has encouraged Provincetown to apply for Cultural District designation; Town Manager Panagore is supportive.

BOS has requested PCCgoals for 2017. We seek Cultural District Designation, and the AIDS Memorial completion, as key goals.
