Show Cause Hearing

The Incensing Board will hold a public hearing to consider whether to suspend, revoke, or put conditions on the Vehicle for Hire Licenses for Sabrina Hash d.b.a. as Junior's Taxi Service and Black & White Taxi at a show-cause hearing to determine if she in violation of Licensing Board Rules & Regulations Section 1.12 (f): Applicants are responsible for providing either a Workers Comp Certificate of Liability Insurance with the Town of Provincetown Licensing Board named as the certificate holder. or a Workers Comp Insurance Affidavit.

The hearing was called to order. Sabrina Hash identified herself and she was sworn in.

The Licensing Agent made his presentation. Two years ago I was informed that taxi drivers should not be considered independent contractors. The state was contacted and that proved to be true. If there are individuals that are driving for a taxi company workers comp must be provided.

Sabrina Hash explained that she is still working with a insurance company regarding workers comp insurance but as of yet she is still waiting for results.

She currently has six drivers working for her and they are not covered. She asked the board for another extension.
