Meeting Minutes

- Meeting called to order at 3:30pm
- Roll Call
- Public Comments: None
- Implementation of Article 5, 6, and 7
 - Copy of Article 7 was provided to the Committee
 - Dr. Singer read Article 7 to the Committee and into the record
 - Dr. Singer provided an overview of salaries in the program
 - Dr. Singer explained that Article 7 funded the existing WeeCare program and not expansion.
 - Dr. Singer provided an overview of state regulations for WeeCare program and discussed enrollment.
 - 10 infants/toddlers (maximum) as of yesterday.
 - A few days a week we have 9 infants/toddlers.
 - Additional staff person for summer is not covered by article.
 - Dr. Singer explained that adding a third staff person will allow for a maximum of four more children.
 - There are currently two non-residents who will pay tuition. Discussion was had regarding only Provincetown students and no non-residents. It was mentioned that these children have been in the program for some time.
 - Dr. Singer explained that in September Provincetown Schools will hire the third staff person which will be funded by existing ELE revolving account. There is currently enough money to fund this position for one year in that account.
 - Ngina suggest a statement for website and suggested an update every two weeks. Some members were concerned about who would be responsible for this and that things change very quickly, the information may not be accurate.



- Dr. Singer provided a final overview, explaining how different WeeCare is than other school programs. She expressed her concern that the school must be responsible but the school cannot take everyone with current funding.
- Cass Benson motioned that “If necessary the Provincetown Schools will hire a third person funded by the ELE revolving account for one year for WeeCare.
 - Eva Enos seconded the motion
