5. Silent Fireworks. Jeff to approach the Chair of the VSB to ask about the history of the fireworks, ie: how they are paid for, and to get on their next agenda to have someone from AWC speak about the upside of quiet fireworks. A motion was made to have the AWC put on the next agenda of the VSB. Motion passed 5-0-0.

Carol went to Town Hall to see about getting on the BOS agenda in favor of quiet fireworks. They need to have an approved motion from the AWC requesting to be put on their agenda. A motion was made to be put on their next available agenda. Motion passed 5-0-0.
