Chair reports that a marker- a granite column with a brass plaque will cost under \$2500, to be located just to the north of the pathway. We will review site prior to final decision. Landscaping discussion next meeting to resolve question of concrete skirt around monument, with a brick margin.

Minutes of March 12 approved unanimously on motion by Burton.

Brochure discussion: Burton circulated a draft of the text. The material has been organized into categories, and is drawn from materials originating with each of the referenced locations. The categories are: Visual Arts, Performing Arts, Festivals, Pilgrims' Landing/ Provincetown Monument, Memorials, Portuguese/Fishing/Whaling, Macmillan Pier, Great Provincetown Schooner Regatta, Communities, and Neighboring Partners, Dune Shacks, Library, and the Rose Dorothea.

We discussed the general content, will seek to have text sections of approx. equal length, and will submit relevant text to each organization for review. Walsh notes addressed the important historic role of women artists here.

A reference to the planned Wampanoag Memorial at the rotary will be included.

The document will be distributed to Council members for edits, to be coordinated by Burton, before a final draft, which we will review when we meet again.
