Minutes of Sept. 18 were approved unanimously.
No public comments were offered

The Tourism brochure has been delayed, and is in final edits. Comments were offered about the colors used on the map.

The 17 applications for 2020 funding from the MCC totaling grant were discussed individually and rated. A total of \$4800 was available to be distributed, with \$10,855 in requests.

Applicants for six projects not selected will be notified, they have a 30-day appeal period before approved applications are notified.

An additional \$400 that would be available if a prior grantee (Song Keepers) does not send a request for payment by Dec. 1. Decision made to grant \$200 each to LCTV and the Provincetown Independent in that event.

AIDS Memorial update: the Beautification Committee has voted not to reduce the height of the Ryder St. hedge.

The sculptor, Lauren Ewing, has offered to pay for a bronze plaque noting "Commissioned by the Provincetown Cultural Council- Artist, Lauren Ewing".

.Funds remaining from the project appear to not be adequate to complete the sidewalk around the Memorial, as well as the granite pedestal and plaque.. Burton will review with DPW Director Waldo to explore options, including reducing sidewalk width from 4' to 3'.
