The Provincetown Recreation Commission will hold a public meeting at 5:30pm on Wednesday, September 2nd, 2020.

Pursuant to Governor Baker's March 12, 2020 Order Suspending Certain Provisions of the Open Meeting Law, G.L. c. 30A, §18, and the Governor's March 15, 2020 Order imposing strict limitation on the number of people that may gather in one place, this meeting of the Provincetown Recreation Commission will be conducted via remote participation to the greatest extent possible.
