

## **Minutes of the Provincetown International Baccalaureate World (IBW) Schools January 27, 2021 School Committee Special Meeting**

1. Eva Enos called the meeting to order at 5:04 pm
2. Roll Call: Eva Enos, Liz Lovati, Penny Sutter, Adrianna Stefani, Ngina Lythcott (absent)  
Staff present: Superintendent, Suzanne Scallion; Principal, Tim Reynolds
3. Public Comments – None.
4. Back to School update: Suzanne Scallion gave information on switch from hybrid to remote learning. In remote until February 5<sup>th</sup>. Pool testing will begin on or about February 8<sup>th</sup>. She would like the committee to consider bringing MYP kids back four days a week, keeping Wednesday remote for all grades for cleaning. Dr. Scallion answered questions from the Committee regarding pool testing.  
Eva Enos moved to give Suzanne authority to go from remote to hybrid four days a week for all students when the data allows it after school vacation. Seconded by Adrianna Stefani. Approved 4-1-0.
