Brown et al.**, seeking a Special Permit pursuant to Article 2, Section 2640, <u>Building Scale</u>, and Article 3, Sections 3110, <u>Change</u>, <u>Extensions</u>, or <u>Alterations</u>, and 3115, <u>Demolition and Reconstruction</u>, of the Zoning By-Laws to demolish an existing structure that is above the neighborhood average scale and replace it with a structure that is 150 cu. ft. smaller, but still above the neighborhood average scale, and in a different location on the property located at **25 Pilgrim Heights Road (Residential 1 Zone)**.
