**Special Town Meeting – Monday, April 7, 2008**

**ARTICLE 2: Wastewater Optimization and Expansion – Borrowing Authorization.**

If the DPW director confirms that the expansion will increase the number of affordable housing units, Provincetown Housing Authority is in support of Article 2.

Provincetown Housing Authority owns Maushope, Foley House and a number of residential units in the community. Affordable housing is the purview of the Provincetown Housing Authority and defeat of this Article would increase cost for the Provincetown Housing Authority and its tenants.
