They are troubled by the fact that the Gifford House assumes all responsibilities though a non-Gifford House employee is handling the Beer and Wine. They suggest perhaps the restaurant seek separate licenses of their own, or have only the Gifford house employees handling the alcohol.

The Gifford House agreed to have the Thai Food Restaurant's customers go over to the Gifford House's bar for any and all types of alcoholic beverage and that no non-Gifford house employee will be pouring or serving alcohol of any type.
