The meeting was called to order at 9:00am

There were some preliminary comments and questions before the review rounds began.

It was thought that there would be more latitude in supporting Applicant #3, The Canadian/New England Cruise with marketing funds, rather than as a grant.

Motion: it is moved to support the efforts of the Canadian/New England Cruise Show with a minimum of \$2,500 from the FY 2010 Marketing budget.

Motion: Rob Tosner **Seconded: Hersh Schwartz** **6-0-0 (Michelle Haynes not yet present)**

The question of in-season versus off-season events elicited some comments, especially that in these economic times, it can't be assumed that an in-season event will automatically be successful, and therefore not worthy of support. It is hoped that the Jazz Festival and Music Festival, for instance, prosper over time and then can be persuaded to move to a shoulder season.

Applicant #23, A Short Wake is seen as a one-time event, and is planned for Labor Day Weekend, which is very busy anyway. The production is certainly welcomed, but will not be supported with a grant.

Motion: it is moved that A Short Wake will not be awarded a grant.

Motion: Rob Tosner **Seconded: Hersh Schwartz** **5-0-1 Mike Peregón (Michelle Haynes not yet present)**

Application #20, PBG-Provincetown Winter Weekends is seen as a valuable enterprise, providing needed entertainment during these off-season times when there will be numbers of people here, but without many other options.

Action Item: Rob Tosner will look into design and construction of a banner and a placard that features the VSB name and logo, and grantees will be required to display same at the funded events.

The VSB is in favor of continuing support for successful events, even if they are years old.
