Present: Paul Hall, John Haylor, Barbara Rushmore, Sheila LaMontagne (prospective member) and Assistant Town Manager David Gardner.

Mary Ann Powers and Cecilia Hall were excused absences.

Paul Hall moved to accept corrected minutes, John Haylor seconded, so voted.

John Haylor is to replace Mary Ann Powers on the sign sub-committee.

Next meeting is to be November 17th, Tuesday at 2pm.

Sub-committee on Signs will see one sign made and installed at MacMillan Wharf at the entrance to the Waterfront Memorial Park. Perhaps later a 2nd sign could be placed at the Cabral Wharf entrance.

Daffodil bulbs: Paul Hall is to give bulbs to Tony Lemne to have them planted this fall on the Grace Hall slope and in beds at the Old Library.

Barbara Rushmore moved to spend \$1000 for a Summer worker at Building and Grounds to plant daffodils and clean up Waterfront Memorial Park. John Haylor seconded, so voted.

David Gardner explained that the Beautification Committee gets its money (\$5000/year) from the VSB and the unspent money carries over. He will let the Committee know the present balance. The VSB is planning \$7000 for Beautification this next fiscal year, 2012.

Future possible projects:

A pamphlet with map and tree leaves for a walking, tree identification tour. Steve Borkowski got copies of the Bristol, R.I. pamphlet for the committee.

Planting plans site by site such as Lower Alden Street triangles.
