



## ***Directors' Statements***

**Carlos Verde:** Thought previous meeting was good. He, Rex and Scott had a productive discussion re bringing latter up to date on financial matters.

**Scott Fraser:** Asked about bonding of Treasurer. Would like to make a motion to authorize any Director to be able to sign Rex's timesheet as he is occasionally out of Town. Will bring up issue again in 'New Business'. Commented on Pier maintenance and rehabilitation based on reading lease and Acts and in light of recent engineering study. Of the opinion that \$50,000 for capital reserve is inadequate. Requesting an agenda item to discuss financial planning and development of a long-range maintenance plan based on engineering study and budget.

**Lee Ash:** Board should assess what needs reorganizing and revising re original Pro forma. Read State Ethics Board finding re Assistant Harbormaster that issue didn't warrant further action on its part and PPPC should handle the matter.

**Winkler floats:** Winkler removed his floats. Valuable in terms of revenue having extra floating dock space on 'T' and being able to connect to transportation float. Old courtesy float pulled out.

**Pearl Street Boat Clean-Up:** Delayed by scheduling with DPW, but will commence next week.

**Cape & Islands Harbormaster's Association:** Notified of grant for thermal imaging night vision monocular. Made for marine environment and capable of recording photos and video. Good for night searches and rescue.

**Auditors:** Moving forward working on cash reconciliation between Town and Pier Corp. Our auditor needs to answer questions from Town's auditor.

**Transients:** Available dock space is full of transient tuna boats. Ice sales are strong.

**Port Security Grant:** Work progressing on raceways under Pier.
