- 1) Bicycle Committee: Candace Nagle- Would like the support of the recreation commission in the following: The bicycle committee is pushing for the approval from the board of selectmen to make bicycle and pedestrian lanes on each side of Bradford Street. Currently we have 15 feet on the north side, and 13' on the south side of Bradford Street, which would give us enough room with a bike and pedestrian lane, and have two ten foot car lanes. The police chief has given his formal support of this last week, and we are gathering up support from local boards, and abutters.
