1. No public attended thus no public statements.
2. The minutes of 7/19/12 were reviewed and approved.
3. A motion was made to submit a budget request of \$944 to the Board of Selectmen for 16 poop bag stations (\$59 each, no shipping charges) which will replace deteriorating dispensers. In addition, this will triple the amount of poop bags per station in a locked, secure dispenser which will be extremely helpful because the volunteer who has been servicing the poop bag dispensers for 6 years is unable to keep up with the current demand of usage for single roll dispensers.

4. 500 tab bands were ordered (250 small/250 large). 500 human wrist bands will identify animal and owners.
5. P-town graphics are doing the cage cards. Animal card forms are in the works. Candace waiting for P-towns' TID certificate to order cage card holders.
6. Site visit to police station animal facility some time in the fall.
7. Outer Cape's police depts' drive for pet food donations for the pet food pantry was a huge success.
7. Discussion regarding the bicycle/pedestrian lane to be added to Bradford Street would contribute to the safety of dog walking as well.
