**New business:**

- 1) VMCC Gym use- Brandon reports on use as Followed: Youth basketball practice from 3-5 each day Monday through Friday. Adult sports Monday Adult basketball 5-8, Tuesday Adult floor hockey 5-8, Wednesday Adult basketball 5-8, Thursday and Friday Adult indoor soccer 5-8.
- 2) The department will be replacing current fiberglass backboards at the VMCC gym, with new glass backboards. The fiberglass backboards were falling apart and were a safety liability, now the glass backboards will provide us with quality equipment for many years.

**Old Business:**

1) Cpa Application- The board is to meet soon and discuss all applications. We will be notified again to meet with CPA if they have questions about our application. The recreation commission should look to meet with CPA some time in January.

**Director's report:**

- 1) Update on move to VMCC – Heating installation is ahead of schedule and will be done before the New Year. However, there remain problems with leaks in the portions of the building. Town manager does not want departments moved in until the leaks are fixed, and the building cleaned.
- 2) Mirror Installation at VMCC – The new aerobics room at the VMCC, needs mirrors to be installed. Brandon has looked into removing ones at current community center, but has been told it is not possible to be removed. We will be required to install new mirrors in that room, and it will have to be paid out of the Recreation gift fund.
