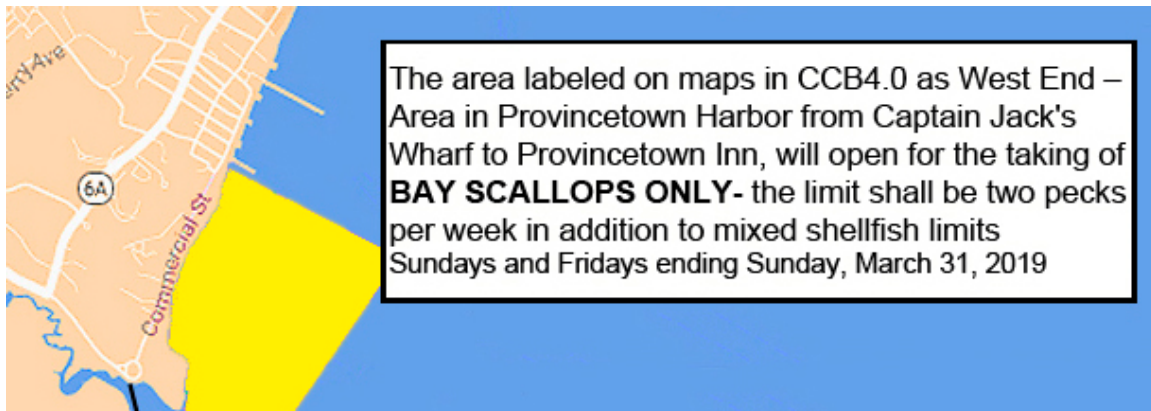
Bay scallops are abundant

On Friday, November 9, 2018 the shellfish area, labeled on maps in CCB4.0 as West End – Area in Provincetown Harbor from Captain Jack's Wharf to Provincetown Inn, will open to the public for the recreational taking of bay scallops only.

This is a recreational harvest and the limit shall be two pecks (two ten-quart baskets) per week in addition to mixed shellfish limits.

The days allowed are Sundays and Fridays through and including Sunday, March 31, 2019.

A Town recreational shellfishing license is required. Fees are \$15.00 for residents and \$50.00 for non-residents. Residents or taxpayers shall be issued a free shellfish permit at age 65 or older. A weekly permit is available to all for the fee of \$25.00.
