Town Engineer

The Town of Provincetown is accepting applications for the position of Town Engineer with the Department of Public Works. This position is responsible for performing highly complex duties that require extensive professional engineering, contracting and procurement expertise; independent judgment; initiative in budgeting, scheduling and administering work assignments. A Bachelor's Degree in Civil Engineering or related engineering field required; five to seven years of professional/technical experience in civil engineering work as a licensed engineer including budgetary and supervisory experience; or any equivalent combination of education and experience. Computer skills/experience in CAD is preferred and required for Microsoft Office applications. Registration as a Professional Engineer by the Commonwealth of MA, Board of Registration or Professional Engineers required. Professional Land Surveyor license is preferred but not required. Valid class D motor vehicle license required and must be able to pass a CORI test post employment offer. This position is a Grade 11 position with a starting pay commensurate with experience.
