PROVINCETOWN MUNICIPAL AIRPORT (PVC)

Replacement of Diesel Standby Generator

Proposals for services at Provincetown Municipal Airport will be received on or before June 11, 2020 at 3:00 p.m. local time. Proposals submitted after this time may not be accepted. Proposals must be submitted via email to the Airport Manager, Mr. Butch Lisenby (butchpvc@hotmail.com) and labeled "**Generator Replacement - Provincetown Municipal Airport - June 11, 2020 - Project Bid**". The proposer shall also list the company's contact information (name, address, email and phone number) in the email.

This project is to replace the existing 125 kW diesel generator, located adjacent to the terminal building at Provincetown Municipal Airport. The scope of work is expected to include the following:

- Secure all applicable permits from local authorities.
- The Contractor shall appropriately lock out the unit and disconnect all electrical connections from the existing generator prior to the start of work.
- Extract diesel fuel from existing generator, and store in UL-listed tank on-site.
- Disconnect, remove, and dispose of existing diesel standby generator.
- Furnish and install one (1) new 125 kW diesel standby generator. The new generator shall be installed on, and secured to, the existing concrete pad. The new generator shall be a self-contained unit with the following features:
 - 125 kW standby power rating.
 - Voltage: 208/120V 3-Phase 60 Hz.
 - Voltage regulator.
 - Microprocessor control panel with low water level shutdown.
 - Weatherproof enclosure, powder coated finish.
 - Sound attenuation installed in enclosure.
 - 450 Amp 3 Pole, 600 V breaker, mounted 7 wired in NEMA 1 enclosure.

- Jacket water heater, 2000W, 240VAC (wired to Terminal Building).
- Dry single stage air cleaner.
- 12-volt battery system with rack and cables.
- Battery charger, 10 Amp (wired to Terminal Building).
- Critical grade compact silencer, mounted to engine.
- 375-gal minimum fuel tank, UL-142 Listed, double wall construction with secondary containment.
- Any exceptions to the above shall be noted on the Bidder's proposal.
- Complete all wiring and connections to existing Terminal Building, to match the current functionality of the existing system.
- Transfer stored diesel fuel to new generator.
- Conduct start-up and testing of the new standby generator, and provide operational training to Airport staff.

Award of the work is pending funding from the MassDOT Aeronautics Division. Bids shall include a signed Certificate of Tax Compliance and Certificate of Non-Collusion. This project is exempt from state sales taxes and local permit fees.

No Bid Security is required for this proposal.

The company awarded the work must furnish a 50% Labor and Materials Payment Bond for each contract awarded.

Wages paid to employees must comply with the minimum established by CH 149, 26-27D, MGL.

The Contractor must comply with requirements of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Affirmative Action Requirements.
