



## Notice of Public Informational Meeting

The Town of Provincetown is embarking on a project to plan, design and construct roadway improvements along Shank Painter Road and Route 6 to improve vehicular access and pedestrian and bicycle accommodations. A Public Informational Meeting will be held by the Provincetown Department of Public Works with the assistance of Environmental Partners, Inc. to discuss the project.

**WHEN:** Thursday, July 20, 2017 at 6 PM

**PURPOSE:** The purpose of the meeting is to provide the public with the opportunity to become fully acquainted with the goals of the proposed project and to solicit input for consideration as proposed alternatives are developed. The goals of the project will be identified, existing deficiencies and site constraints will be highlighted and evaluations of the project corridor will be presented. The public will be invited to discuss their concerns of existing conditions within the project limits and recommend improvements and features. Concepts of alternatives will be presented to facilitate the conversation and to solicit input. The input will be used to select components or features of the design that will be included in advanced alternatives presented at future meetings.

**PROPOSAL:** The proposed project is anticipated to include improvements to traffic circulation and safety, and pedestrian and bicycle facilities along Shank Painter Road from the intersection of Bradford Street to the intersection of Route 6 for an approximate length of 2,900 feet. It will also include a 1.1 mile segment of Route 6 to link pedestrian and bicycle accommodations from Shank Painter Road to Herring Cove Beach and the National Seashore.
