

**Final Design & Construction Phase Services  
Request for Proposals for the  
Restoration of the  
Bas Relief & Bas Relief Park  
Town of Provincetown, Massachusetts  
August 2017**

In accordance with M.G.L. Chapter 44, Section 53G and Chapter 30B, The Town of Provincetown invites proposals from qualified professionals, herein called qualified proposers, for the Final Design and Construction Phase Services for its historic Bas Relief and Bas Relief Park at 106 Bradford Street. The Town of Provincetown (the "Town") seeks a multi-disciplinary team to finalize and assist the Town in implementing the *Master Conservation Plan for the Bas Relief and Bas Relief Park* prepared by Ray Dunetz Landscaping Architecture, Inc. ("RDLA") in December 2016. Key tasks include refining the design of the historic Bas Relief Park, preparing bid documents, and providing construction phase services to implement the conservation of the monuments, foremost of which is the Cyrus Dallin-designed bronze bas relief, and the landscape restoration plan. Total project costs including design, management, and construction are not-to-exceed \$750,000.

A briefing session will be held on Tuesday, September 12, 2017 at 2:00 pm at Town Hall, 260 Commercial Street. All interested parties are strongly urged to attend. The Contractor should make him/herself familiar with the *Master Conservation Plan for the Bas Relief and Bas Relief Park* prepared by Ray Dunetz Landscaping Architecture, Inc. ("RDLA") in December 2016, which is available at the Town's website, and the Bas Relief Park prior to the briefing session.

Proposals are due **by Thursday October 5, 2017 at 4:00 p.m.** to: Town Manager/Chief Procurement Officer, Town of Provincetown, 260 Commercial Street, Provincetown, Massachusetts, 02657. Late proposals will not be considered and faxed proposals will not be accepted. The selected proposer shall be determined by the Town Manager and is subject to final approval by the Board of Selectmen. Said Board is expected to award a contract on or before **November 2017**. The Town of Provincetown reserves the right to withdraw the Request for Proposal; to reject any and all proposals; and to accept any proposal deemed to be in the best interest of the Town of Provincetown.
