The Provincetown Recycling and Renewable Energy Committee and the Department of Public Works are proud to announce a town-wide cleanup in celebration of Earth Day 2018.

As part of the Keep Massachusetts Beautiful program, Ptown Streets & Beaches Cleanup will join towns throughout the Commonwealth during the month of April in a united effort to clear the roadways, woods, streams, lakes and seashore of plastic pollution and other debris.

The Provincetown cleanup will take place on Saturday, April 21, from 10am – 12pm, coinciding with the Center for Coastal Studies' spring beach cleanup.

Volunteers are needed to help pick up litter along our short streets, our long beaches, and everything in between. Safety vests will be provided by DPW, bags and gloves will be provided by CCS. Julie Knapp, owner of Twisted Pizza and supporter of many community events, has offered a coupon for free pizza to all volunteers.

Registration for both the street and beach cleanups is required. Meeting and cleanup locations will be throughout town, based on participation.
