Eric Dray says that David Dunlap has a searchable category for artists' studios from which the Commission can build from. Therefore, a studio tour brochure should be achievable for 2014.

The National Seashore has placed a tarp over the roof of the Biddle house. The house is in very poor condition.

Richard Olson of the Cemetery Commission states that the Commission has planned a plaque dedicated to the victims of the small pox epidemic. It will be based on the ledger stone as seen in Boston's Old Granary and Kings Chapel Burial Ground.

Stephen Borkowski informed the Commission that the 'Abolitionists Society' headed by Nathan Freeman met in what is now the Provincetown Public Library. The Commission should perhaps consider a plaque or stone on the grounds of the Library.
