### **Chief's Report**

Plaque for new Rescue Vehicle 196 in memory of Doug Trumbo has been ordered.

Paramedic Skip Childs now works at the Highway Garage in town and is available if needed. Also, under the LCA Mutual Aid agreement, Paramedic Dan Notaro will be allowed to respond to calls and use the department rescue vehicle if both LCA trucks are out of town.

Two letters received from Tim Rowell's attorney, Jamie Veara, regarding Rowell's status in the department. Letter will be sent to Rowell.

Correspondence regarding Antenna to be installed on roof at Main Station for Emergency Management Communications discussed. N/Star Electric suggested that Provincetown and Truro have a designated phone line so that equipment and faxes could be plugged in during storm activities. Location of line should be at Main Station. Jeff Lucey of Com/Electric will be contacted regarding the line and forms to be used.

Anchor Inn has an addressable alarm system, ACK (acknowledge) must be hit first. Letter from Peter Boyle requesting permission to change smoke detector # 16, located in the kitchen off of the office, to a heat detector. Chief approved the change. Lock box is located on the front NW side of the building that contains a key to the front door as well as a key to the alarm system box. Third key to Knox boxes will be transferred from Bill Ingraham to Jim Roderick. Knox box paperwork will be updated with Roderick's name.
