Licensing Board Statements

Todd Wagar suggests making all licenses 12 months by default and thinks that the Rules & Regulations should be simplified. Mr. Wagar believes that the first suggestion of making a seasonal business valid from April 1st until October 31st is too limiting and would like to update and adopt a more precise definition using the number of months. Also, instead of an annual business only being allowed to be closed for 30 days, it should be extended to 60 days and the fees for liquor should be dramatically changed. Cass Benson suggests that board members work on putting out ideas to the public for an April Public Hearing. Ms. Benson asks the Licensing Agent to schedule a work session for the February 10th meeting.
