The Provincetown Conservation Commission will hold a Public Hearing at 6:00 p.m. on **Tuesday, December 15, 2020**, in Provincetown, MA, to consider the following requests:

CON-20-2061 49A Commercial Street

Notice of Intent filed by Artemis Simopoulos and Daphne Pinkerson, Trustees of Alan Pinkerson Family Trust, pursuant to the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act (M.G.L. c. 131, s. 40) and the Provincetown General Bylaws Chapter 12, Wetlands Protection Bylaw, to extend existing timber bulkhead return, improve deck foundation system, and reinstall fender piles seaward of timber bulkhead. Work to take place within Land Subject to Coastal Storm Flowage (V Zone), Coastal Beach, and Buffer Zone to Coastal Beach.
