

CEMETERY COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES

MARCH 26TH, 2021

MEETING WAS HELD VIA TELECONFERENCE AT 1:00PM.

PRESENT: MIKE HARPIE, LYNNE MARTIN, SHARON BUNN, MICHAEL CHUTE

EXCUSED ABSENCE: CHRISTOPHER BROOKE, DAWN WALSH, JASON BROWN

(JASON AND DAWN WERE UNABLE TO ENTER THE MEETING DUE TO A TECHNOLOGICAL MALFUNCTION)

MINUTES FROM OUR PRIOR MEETING WERE DISCUSSED, REWORDED, AND APPROVED.

A VOTE WAS TAKEN ON WHETHER TO APPROVE THE PROPOSED SEPTIC ORIGINAL PLAN, THE REVISED PLAN, OR NOT TO APPROVE. AFTER A LENGTHY DISCUSSION, WE VOTED TO APPROVE THE REVISED PLAN WITH THE FOLLOWING STIPULATIONS: "so long as the new water line leading to the building is installed in an area that will **not go through the ground directly to the right of the existing cremations. Also, the areas surrounding the Maintenance Garage will be made free from storage of all non-cemetery related refuse and materials, trash/recycling containers, etc. Also, all found or broken monuments and markers will be neatly arranged, categorized, and stored within a **secured area** to the right or to the rear of the Maintenance Garage."**

JASON BROWN HAD ASKED IF THE CEMETERY COMMISSION WOULD REIMBURSE HIM FOR ANOTHER 5 GALLONS OF D-2 SO THAT HE COULD CONTINUE TO CLEAN MARKERS. THE CEMETERY COMMISSION UNANIMOUSLY VOTED TO REIMBURSE HIM, WITH GREAT APPRECIATION AND THANKS FOR HIS WORK.

AFTER BEGINNING TO REVIEW THEM, WE AGREED THAT SINCE SOME KEY MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION WERE NOT ABLE TO ENTER THE MEETING, THAT THE FINALIZATION OF OUR RULES AND REGULATIONS WOULD BE POSTPONED UNTIL NEXT MEETING.
