  - c. Discussed possible Bike Month activities for May. Rik said he is waiting to hear what the COVID regulations will allow. Tracy said she will check with Brandon, the Recreation Dept. director, so see if there's interest in a bike rodeo to do safety checks and give out helmets.
  - d. Steve provided updates on DPW projects:
    - i. Conwell St bike lanes and sidewalk are is under construction with expected June completion
    - ii. Bradford/Prince striping will happen in the next 2-3 weeks
    - iii. Shank Painter redesign is pretty much done. Possible construction in 2024.
