

Provincetown Building Committee
Meeting Minutes
June 2, 2021, 4:30 pm

The Provincetown Building Committee held a remote public meeting on June 2, 2021 at 4:30pm in keeping with Governor Baker's Executive Order of March 12, 2020, *Order Suspending Certain Provisions of the Open Meeting Law*.

There were no statements from the public.

Having taken into consideration several concerns voiced by voters in public and individual communications related to him by the Building Committee, Town Manager and staff about design of a new PPD building Jorge Cruz began discussion about the process of planning a new Provincetown Police Station.

Beginning with the current design, he discussed changes to exterior treatments, window configurations, roof top configuration, etc. The Committee asked questions and made suggestions obtained in discussions they had individually with members of the public

Paul Kelly asked to see gable roof on the section of the building fronting Route 6, also an overall shed roof design. He requested Flansburgh consider deleting the second story of the section fronting Route 6, and move the archival storage area to the attic of the main section of the building fronting Jerome Smith.

Jorge Cruz will present options to address Committee members' and the public's concerns at the next meeting.

Lisa Westervelt asked about including solar panels on the building. Jorge said it would be delivered solar ready. David Gardner said that solar panels will be added after initial construction at no additional cost.

The meeting adjourned with the plan to discuss Flansburgh's design iterations at a meeting June 23, 2021 at 3pm.
