Harbor Regulation **3-2-3** Dinghies and vessels routinely (more than seven consecutive days) stored above the mean high waterline along the beaches must first obtain a permit from the Harbormaster. The Harbormaster shall issue a beached boat ID permit upon formal application and payment of all fees. Permit stickers must be affixed to the vessel as required. Effective January 1, 2015, new beached boat permits are valid from April 15th through November 15th of the year issued. All beached boats must be removed by the permit expiration date. Boats left on public beaches after the expiration date. Boats left on public beaches after the expiration date are subject to removal pursuant to 3-2- 3(b).²⁸
