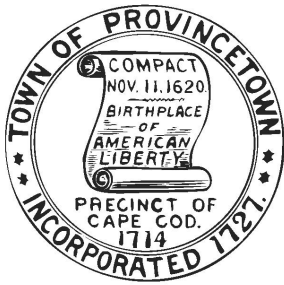
To Participate during public comment:
