It was determined that they would be the sole arbiter of the decision.

The Chair informed the board of the injury to the carpenter working on the mural project, and said that we would delay any work until his recovery, since he had intimate knowledge of the project.

The chair showed the Commission a prototype label holder to be reviewed by them and for the eventual review of the Town Manager, Building Commissioner, etc. It was decided to move forward with the design review process, as the Art Commission was satisfied with the design.

The project managers recommendation for the moving slightly to the east of it's original location the statue "Tourists" by Chaim Gross. A copy of the plans were reviewed and approved by the members of the art commission.

The Chair circulated a letter received regarding the moving of the Harvey Dodd's watercolors, after a full discussion no action was taken.
