The following are meeting minutes, in brief:

**RECEIVE CPC FUNDING PROPOSALS**

Chair Elaine Anderson opened the proposals and Vice Chair Mona Anderson recorded a list of the proposals and the amounts requested. The proposals had all been received before 5:00 p.m. on February 5<sup>th</sup>, 2007.

1. The first proposal was from Thanassi Kuliopulos for 6 Sandy Hill Lane for affordable housing.
2. The next proposal was from the BOS for restoration of the Town Hall clock. This was a request for \$20,000 from the historic funding.
3. The third request was also from the BOS for \$100,000 to establish a revolving loan fund for betterment of the sewer infrastructure. This would be under affordable housing.
4. The fourth proposal was submitted by Doug Johnstone, on behalf of the Provincetown History Preservation Project. The request was for \$17,635 to help create a climate-controlled storage area in the library for historic documents and would come under historic funding.

The committee members would receive a copy of each proposal and would discuss them at the regularly scheduled meeting the following day.
