**New business:**

- 1) Carrie asks for update on playground surfacing. Is concerned that adding sand or replacing with wood chips will be expensive. IF we are to replace the sand, with the new mason sand, as required, who can tell that it won't be black in a year or less.  
Brandon- There is an alternative solution to sand and wood chips, the department can install rubber pour in place material. The price per square foot will be more expensive that sand or woods chips, but it will be a one time installment, and easier on maintenance. The pour in place, will be the same surface that we have installed at Chelsea earnest for the handi cap walk way. I will get a price per square foot, and we can make a better decision with that price.

**Old Business:**

1) Cpa Application- CPA has invited Brandon to attend their January 22<sup>nd</sup> meeting to discuss the department's project. Brandon has received a list of questions the board has, and he will report back to them at that meeting.

**Director's Report:**

1) Transition to VMCC- Heating system has been installed and work on the heat has been finished. The town is now in the process of fixing leaks in the roof, and cleaning up the building. An approximate date of the end of February has been given to Brandon for move in.

- 2) Winter Sports – New basketball backboards and hoops are up in the VMCC gym, and look sharp. The department has youth basketball Monday – Friday 3-5. After five the VMCC gym is used for adult sports from 5-8. Adult sports consist of Adult basketball on Monday & Wednesdays, Floor Hockey on Tuesdays, and Adult indoor Soccer on Thursdays and Fridays. Also starting January 19<sup>th</sup>, the Vmcc gym will be used on Saturdays for the Fitness challenge.

**Assistant Directors Report:**

1) Movie night- The department will be offering a movie night on Fridays to children ages 5 and up. Starting this Friday parents will be able to drop off their children at 5:30 for a choice of two movies. The department will not be charging for this event, and popcorn will be served.
