**I. JOHN ANDERSON FRANCIS FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP**, established by the will of Cecilia C. Francis

A. Eligibility

This Scholarship is available only to students who (check the one which applies to you):

1. graduated from Provincetown High School in or prior to 2013 \_\_\_\_\_ or
2. completed the entire eighth grade at Provincetown Schools after 2009 and went on to graduate from a high school on Cape Cod. \_\_\_\_\_

This Scholarship may be awarded to students who are (check the one which applies to you):

1. entering your Freshman year of college \_\_\_\_\_ or
2. currently enrolled in college, graduate school, or a professional school. \_\_\_\_\_

B. Requirements

This Scholarship may be awarded on an annual basis for up to four years of college, and two years of post-graduate study or professional school (i.e., six times per student).

- For those entering college as a freshman, the application deadline is May 15.

If awarded, the Scholarship is paid after proof is received by the Committee of successful completion of the first semester. See the list below for what is required to prove successful completion.

- For students already in college or graduate or professional school, the application deadline is October 1. Applications must include proof of successful completion of the prior year. See the list below for what is required to prove successful completion.

C. Proof of successful completion requires submitting all of the following:

1. a transcript of all courses completed to date, \_\_\_\_\_

**II. CAPTAIN JOSEPH F. OLIVER SCHOLARSHIP**, established by the will of Captain Joseph F. Oliver

**A. Eligibility**

This Scholarship is available only to students who:

1. Resided at the time of graduation from high school in Provincetown \_\_\_\_\_ or Truro \_\_\_\_\_, and
2. Graduated from:
  - a. Provincetown High School in, or prior to, 2013 \_\_\_\_\_, or
  - b. A Cape Cod high school after 2013 \_\_\_\_\_, and

**B. Requirements**

This Scholarship may be awarded on an annual basis for up to three years of college and two years of post-graduate study (i.e., up to five times per student).

For all students the application deadline is October 1. Applications must include proof of successful completion of the prior year. See the list below for what is required to prove successful completion.

**C. Proof of successful completion requires submitting all of the following:**

1. A transcript of all courses completed to date \_\_\_\_\_,

**III. TOWN SCHOLARSHIP**, established by the Town of Provincetown.

**A. Eligibility**

This Scholarship will be awarded to a student entering their Freshman year of college who meets all of the following requirements:
